Prepare for Settlement

	Finalise your finances	
	Send your conveyancer the documents received from the seller or agent	
	Provide 100 points of identification (e.g., passport, driver's license, birth certificate)	
	Verify your identity	
	Insure the property	
	Make your stamp duty payment (consult your paralegal for your state's requirements)	
	Arrange a pre-settlement inspection	
	Pay your conveyancing invoice	
	Organise your move using services like Property Helper	
Settlement Day		
	Your lender transfers the settlement amount to the seller	
	Conveyancer confirms settlement is complete	
	Agent hands over the keys to your new home	
	Request the registration confirmation from your bank to certify official transfer of ownership
